Believers are given the choice to be single or not: Matthew 19:3-12

Jesus taught about marriage/divorce: Matthew 5:31-32, Mark 10:2-12, Luke 16:18, death of a spouse unbinds the marriage contract (Romans 7:2, 1 Corinthians 7:

There is a grey area of abandonment by an unbelieving spouse: 1 Corinthians 7:15

The Gospel is all about Reconciliation and Restoration, the goal is to be led by the Spirit and live for the Lord: Ephesians 4:17-24, Colossians 1:21-23, Romans 3:23-24, Romans 8:5-14, Galatians 5:16-23

- 1) Believers should marry like-minded believers (Philippians 2:1-2)
- 2) Don’t rush into relationships (Song of Songs 2:7)
- 3) Pre-marital counseling will help you find out more about the person you are about to spend the rest of your life with (Proverbs 11:14, 12:15)
